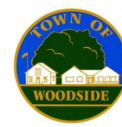


Woodside Fire Protection District CHIPPER PROGRAM

Mission Statement



It is the mission of the Woodside Fire Protection District to protect life, property and the environment through prevention, education, preparedness, and emergency response.



What is the Chipper Program?

The Chipper Program is a free hazardous fuel reduction program to help promote fire resiliency. Funded by the Towns of Woodside, Portola Valley and WFPD.

In 2005, with a Woodside-Portola Valley Fire Protection Foundation grant, a chipper and truck were purchased. The program goal is to assist residents in maintaining defensible space around their homes.

How can I participate?

Your neighborhood will be assigned a designated day when chipping will take place. Stack your material by 7:00 a.m. along the roadside no more than 14 days prior to your scheduled chipping day. Confirm your chipping date by going to www.WoodsideFire.org.



What can be chipped?

Brush & tree limbs up to 8" diameter. Material must be free of nails, rocks, screws, rope or wire as it can damage the chipper.

The chipper cannot chip the following:

Vines, dirt, root balls, leaf piles, milled lumber, eucalyptus bark, or poison oak.

When will the chipper be on my street?

PLEASE

Don't stack piles more than 14 days in advance!



Please do not obstruct the roadway when stacking materials. Incorrectly stacked piles WILL NOT BE CHIPPED!

Stacking Requirements

- Cut ends out facing street
- Pile NO larger than 10 ft x 10 ft
- Do not stack trimmings on dry grass.

Size and stacking procedures:

Vegetation should be piled along the roadside with cut ends facing towards street. Please limit pile to 10 ft x 10 ft. Material will be chipped back onto site where appropriate.
